

An outdoor enthusiast, Amy has been living in Washington since 2013. "We were purposeful in coming here. We can see the San Juan Islands and the foothills of the Cascades." After retiring from a career in public health, she now serves as a part-time consultant for the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, a philanthropic organization, and is an active community volunteer.

Before moving west, she and her family had lived in East Lansing, Mich. She even remembers when Michigan Flyer was first launched: "It's such a wonderful asset to the area. The drivers are always so nice, and the bus is so clean and comfortable. I still absolutely depend on it when I come back to visit my daughter and her family who live there."

Everyone on the bus was delighted in my tears of joy and their shrieks and running to hug me. Talk about feeling the slings and arrows of good fortune!

# Our New Daily Schedule Gives You More DTW Flight Options

Michigan Flyer now makes it easier for you to connect with approximately 700 daily nonstop flights between Detroit Metro Airport (DTW) and top domestic and international destinations. Our schedule recently grew from nine to 12 roundtrips per day. We added three Eastbound runs #8000, #8004, and #8024, along with three Westbound runs #8001, #8005, and #8023 as shown HERE.

The early morning Eastbound runs help passengers connect with the cheapest flights out of DTW, while the later Westbound runs benefit those who've long wanted


our last bus of the day to leave the airport at 9:45 or 10 p.m. instead of 8:15 or 8:30 p.m. www.MichiganFlyer.com.

#### Fewer Michigan Flyer Runs on Christmas Eve

On Sunday, Dec. 24, we will operate some—but not all—of our Eastbound and Westbound runs. Yet, on Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, and New Year's Day, we plan to operate our full daily schedule of 12 roundtrips. #### Holiday Downtimes for D2A2 Express Bus

The D2A2 Express Bus between Detroit and Ann Arbor will not operate during the Christmas and New Year holidays (Dec. 24, 25, 31, and Jan. 1). On normal weekdays, the luxury motorcoaches of D2A2 offer 16 eco-friendly roundtrips between Detroit's Grand Circus Park (1508 Park Ave.) and Ann Arbor's Blake Transit Center (328 S. Fifth St.), plus eight roundtrips on weekends. See the schedule here. The D2A2 service was created by the Regional Transit Authority of Southeast Michigan in partnership with the Ann Arbor Area Transportation Authority, and is operated by Michigan Flyer.

#### Our New Office Hours Starting January 10

The Michigan Flyer office at the East Lansing Marriott will be staffed from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday starting Jan. 10, 2024. But on Saturday and Sunday after that, there will be no in-person service at the office, nor will reservations be taken by phone. In addition, our office will be closed on Monday, Dec. 25, and Monday, Jan. 1.

scheduled departure. You can easily change reservations online here.

#### Discount Parking to be Eliminated in Ann Arbor

If you're a Michigan Flyer-AirRide passenger who's used to parking a car in the structure at the corner of 4th Ave. and William St. downtown, then you should know that the discounted parking rate of **\$2 per day** is going away. As of Jan. 8, 2024, the rate will be **\$1.20 per hour** Monday through Saturday. The Ann Arbor Downtown Development Authority (DDA), which manages the structure for the city, will no longer offer the discounted parking rates. # Delta Adds DTW-LAX Flights for the Rose Bowl on Jan. 1

To transport more football fans to attend the clash between the University of Michigan and Alabama in Pasadena, Calif., on New Year's Day, Delta Airlines is adding flights to its regular DTW-LAX schedule. Specifically, the airline is offering two more flights departing from Detroit (one each on Dec. 30 and 31), and two more returning flights, both on Jan. 2. Our spot

check found that the economy fare for a roundtrip departing on Dec. 30 would be \$1,728, and \$2,348 for those departing on Dec. 31.

When we checked last Sunday, tickets to the Rose Bowl game itself were still available, although at a cost of roughly \$450-\$2,500 each from online vendors such as SeatGeek.com and StubHub.com.

# Airfares to Warm, Romantic Places for Valentine's Day

Using <u>SkyScanner.com</u>, we set out to scout prices for a sample trip that includes Valentine's Day. We chose Saturday, Feb. 10, for the departure from DTW, and Sunday, Feb. 17, for the return. As usual, our search




criteria required that the flights be non-stop in both directions, and had to arrive back at DTW in time for you to catch Michigan Flyer's last run at 9:45/10 p.m. to Ann Arbor, Brighton, and East Lansing. We discovered dozens of warm and potentially romantic destinations. The following economy roundtrip fares include taxes but not necessarily baggage or other "extras":
