Our New Schedule Starts Oct. 1: Check Out What's In It For You

As reported in the <u>August issue of E-News</u>, Michigan Flyer is expanding its shuttle service on October 1 with two more daily runs between our home base at the East Lansing Marriott and Detroit Metro Airport (DTW). Plus, we're establishing a new stop in Brighton.

What does this mean for folks traveling out of East Lansing? For one thing, because our luxury motorcoaches will make more daily roundtrips to DTW, you'll be able to match them with a greater number of airline departures and arrivals.

For another, just as 30,000 passengers a year use Michigan Flyer to commute between East Lansing and Ann Arbor, you'll soon be able to ride with us to Brighton and back each day. On weekdays, for example, commuters can choose from among 11 daily roundtrips between East Lansing and Brighton, eight between East Lansing and Ann Arbor, or six between Ann Arbor and Brighton.

Benefits of Our Expanded Schedules

BETTER CHOICE. Specifically, Sunday through Friday, Michigan Flyer passengers will be able to choose from 14 runs per day (up from 12, except on Saturday.) So, you'll be better able to reduce wait times at DTW, and optimize your connections with all 13 airlines at DTW.

MORE AIRLINES. Our first run each day will depart East Lansing earlier than now, at 2:15 a.m. Our last run from DTW Sunday through Friday will leave later than now, at 11:30 p.m. or 11:45 p.m. (depending on the

terminal that serves your airline), and at 9:30 p.m. or 9:45 p.m. on Saturday. View the new schedules online here.

Our earlier departures from East Lansing (and later returns from DTW) should be a big help to people who book flights on budget airlines such as Spirit, Frontier, or Southwest, which often take off between 5:30 a.m. and 6:30 a.m.

SHORTER TRIPS. In order to provide the most direct service for each community (East Lansing, Brighton, and Ann Arbor) at peak travel times, as of Oct. 1 some of our daily runs will NOT stop at every location. For example, our shortest runs from East Lansing will go directly to DTW after stopping in Brighton—bypassing Ann Arbor altogether. This shaves about 20 minutes off our travel time to DTW. commuter convenience. Our new Brighton stop is conveniently located for commuters—at the Meijer store at 8650 W. Grand River Ave.—just off highway I-96 near U.S. 23. Michigan Flyer will pick up and drop off passengers at the south side of the Meijer parking lot, near Cross St.



SAME GREAT LOCATIONS AT DTW. Our convenient pick-up/drop-off locations for all Detroit Metro Airport travelers will remain the same—at Door #1

Metro Airport travelers will remain the same—at Door #1 of the McNamara Terminal's Departures/Ticketing Level, and at Stall #1 of the North Terminal's Ground Transportation Center.

PLEASE NOTE: While all Michigan Flyer departures from East Lansing will go to Detroit Metro Airport, NOT all 22 departures from DTW will return to East Lansing. Some will go only as far west as Ann Arbor or Brighton. So, if you tend to buy tickets from our drivers at DTW

instead of getting them in advance online, be sure to confirm with the driver that your bus is actually going to your destination.

Also, it's wise to use our free smartphone app to track your bus in real time.
